1. Write an essay on any topic that relates to: **Human Communication and Technology** (It's ok to submit a paper you've turned in to any of your classes, or an original paper written just for this competition!)
2. Submit **TWO** hard copies of your essay to Dr. Meredith Guthrie (1117 Cathedral of Learning) **by 5pm Friday, December 16.**
3. Essay Requirements:
 - a. 500-1000 words
 - b. Typed, double-spaced
 - c. Identification page with:
 - i. Essay Title
 - ii. Your Name
 - iii. Your PeopleSoft Number
 - iv. Your Phone Number
 - v. Your Address
 - vi. **(DO NOT PUT YOUR NAME ON ANY OTHER PART OF YOUR PAPER!

 - d. Title Page with the title of the essay
 - e. Your essay (Put the title of your essay on the header of each page, please)
